PART 1 - Admissions to the 2025-2026 school year

Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2025 - 2026

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	October 1 st
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	November 4
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	November 25
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Two weeks

***Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Special Class Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2025 - 2026

The following are the dates applicable for admission to the school's Special Class which caters for children on the autistic spectrum, within the mild range of learning disability. The school may refuse to admit to these classes a student who does not have the category of needs specified.

The school will commence accepting applications for admission to the special class on	October 1st
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to the special class on	November 4
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	November 25
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Two weeks

***Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn**

Number of places being made available in 2025 - 2026

The number of places being made available in Junior Infants is	75
The number of places being made available in the special class* catering for children on the autistic spectrum, within the mild range of learning disability is 0 as there is no child leaving Sixth class. If a place becomes available, those who have applied and are on a waiting list will be considered.	0

When the capacity of the school develops the school will be able to have three special classes for children with autism and each class will be able to cater for 6 children, giving a total of 18 children. If children leave these classes to move to mainstream classes or to go to another school at the end of the school year, places will become available that can be offered to other children in the following year.
